




The Band of the Castle Guard and Police of the Czech Republic is a large wind orchestra which has been representing Czech musical culture in a highly professional fashion for more than seventy years, not only at home, but also abroad. Its establishment in 1945 carried on a rich tradition of military, police and gendarme bands from the First Czechoslovak Republic. They were ensembles which were always an integral part of our musical culture and also an example of the nation's musical development.

The primary duties of the Band of the Castle Guard and Police of the Czech Republic include musical accompaniment at all state ceremonies at Prague Castle, primarily state visits and initial audiences with ambassadors.

The orchestra is a significant cultural representative of the Police of the Czech Republic and also performs all tasks resulting from this position.

The ensemble also includes smaller groups the Domino Woodwind Trio, the Prague Brass Sextet, The Brass Quintet, the Brass Octet,

Their focus and repertoire suitably supplement the orchestra's wide range of activities.

In addition to its duties, the orchestra has always given concerts and made recordings. It has made more than twenty CDs.

The orchestra's most important annual concert activities include performing at the Prague Spring International Music Festival and during the Saint Wenceslas celebrations.

The Band of the Castle Guard and Police of the Czech Republic has toured sixteen countries in Europe, Mongolia, Japan and the USA, where it headlined at the famous Carnegie Hall in 2002.

Important event in the life of the orchestra was the presentation of the orchestra at the Vatican in 2015.

The Hungarian Police Band has a nine decade long history; it has been established on 1st December 1923. The founder and first conductor was Ferenc Szőlőssy, who's sacrificing work made the band one of the favorite bands of the music-lover public of 1930's Budapest.

In the 50's and 60's the band was functioning as a symphonic orchestra on one hand, and as a brass band on the other. After its reorganization, the independent brass band was formed in 1978. In 2008, due to the integration, with the concentration of the Police Band and the Border Guard Band, today's Hungarian Police Band has been set up. All members of the Band finished the Hungarian Academy of Music, and the Hungarian College of Art. Besides their uniformed musician career at the Police, they are known and recognized for their work in the civil musical life as well.

The Hungarian Police Band is a permanent performer at events organized by the Ministry of Interior, the Police Force, the local councils and civil organizations.
