

Information on the guarantor and the end user of the grant from the Norwegian Funds 3

The guarantor of PDP 1 and PDP 2 projects and the end user is the Police Education and Service Training Department (abbreviated as ÚPVSP).

ÚPVSP is an organizational unit of the Police of the Czech Republic with nationwide responsibilities. It is a specialized, methodological, managing, control and executive workplace. The department manages police education, service training and police sport under specified conditions and ensures professional training necessary for police service. In cooperation with the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic, it significantly contributes to the ensuring international education provided by European and non-European agencies, associations and other entities.

ÚPVSP was set up on 1 July 2015 by Regulation of the Ministry of the Interior No. 32/2015, which establishes the units of the Police of the Czech Republic with nationwide competence.

At present, the department implements vocational education in six separate educational institutions, namely in Prague - Hrdlořezy, Brno, Holešov, Jihlava, Pardubice and in Prague-Ruzyně.

The Police Education and Service Training Department provides the following activities, in particular:

- sets up the concept of police education, service training and police sport,
- sets up and applies a system of professional training for police officers and employees,
- performs analytical, planning, methodological, control and coordination activities in the field of police education, service training and police sport,
- provides school police centers and service training departments of regional police directorates with methodological guidance, coordinates their activities in ensuring police education and service training,
- coordinates police sport and provides methodological guidance in this field, organizes police championships and international competitions,
- prepares, approves and implements educational programs and educational projects and comprehensively ensures police education,
- ensures service training, including police officer testing,
- cooperates with the Ministry of the Interior, with higher and secondary police schools of the Ministry of the Interior, the Police Academy of the Czech Republic in Prague and other organizational units of the state established by the Ministry of the Interior in providing police education in these schools,

- ensures international police education and cooperates with the Ministry of the Interior in promoting the interests of the police in international education agencies,
- prepares projects in the field of police education, service training and police sport, co-financed mainly from extra-budgetary sources.

The main priorities of the ÚPVSP include:

- ensuring a high level of all educational events covering the widest possible range of police issues,
- be a partner of the executive departments of the Police of the Czech Republic and implement their requirements for professional training,
- use of modern didactic, methodological and pedagogical forms and methods in the implementation of professional education,
- introduction of e-learning and b-learning elements into all educational events and their effective use,
- achieving and maintaining a high professional, methodological and pedagogical level of all employees of the department who provide professional education,
- ensuring modern teaching and didactic equipment, including all equipment used by the Police of the Czech Republic within the service (police vehicles, technical equipment, hardware and software, etc.),
- being a full, equal and recognized partner in international structures in the field of professional training,
- effective cooperation with national and international educational institutions and similar entities providing professional training,
- active use of extra-budgetary funds intended for the modernization and streamlining of material and other support provided in the field of professional training of members of the security and armed forces,
- building and supporting police culture and professional pride in belonging to the Police of the Czech Republic, especially among new members of the Police of the Czech Republic.
